Elklan's Communication Friendly Home-Based Setting Programme Research Places

As part of the Department of Education's Early Years Recovery Programme, Pen Green Stronger Practice Hub (SPH), in the East Midlands and the EEF are working together to fund childminders' access to Elklan's Communication Friendly Home-Based Settings (CFHBS) Programme. The University of York and the University of Sheffield will study the programme's influence on the knowledge, skills and confidence of the childminders as well as explore its feasibility for more widespread implementation.

What are the benefits of taking part?

- As a childminder taking part in the programme, you will receive in depth training through either:
 - Elklan's Let's Talk with Under 5s (LTU5s) and Creating Communication Friendly Home-Based Settings (CFHBS) OR
 - Elklan's Speech and Language Support for 3-5s (SLS3-5s) and Creating Communication Friendly Home-Based Settings (CFHBS)
 - The course will give you enhanced knowledge about speech, language and communication development and how to support this for all children but particularly for those who have, or are at risk of having, a speech, language or communication need. You will gain accreditation at either level 1 (Let's Talk with Under 5s route) or level 3 (Speech and Language Support for 3-5s route) through an Ofqual approved and regulated national awarding organisation.



- You will learn with and from other childminders during live webinars.
- You will consider and develop the opportunities, resources and interactions provided in your home to support the speech, language and communication development of all the children they care for, with guidance from an Elklan Tutor.
- You will receive a Communication Friendly Home-Based Setting award (renewable after 3 years).
- You will receive a total of £446.25 or £536.25 (depending on whether you follow the LTU5s or SLS 3-5s route to gaining the award) towards the costs of your time in completing the programme and supporting the research.





What is involved in the CFHBS programme?



CFHBS through Let's Talk with Under 5s (LTU5s)

- You will attend 8 live group webinars in groups of approximately 10, to discuss your learning with an Elklan Tutor and with each other and have opportunities to reflect on the implementation of strategies from the course and share experiences in consistent small groups. The webinars total 16.5 hours and are held at the same time and day of the week throughout the programme, excluding half terms and school holidays. Timetables are provided on the final pages.
- There are no eLearning sessions for the LTU5s route. All the learning is via live webinars.
- You will complete an online learning log of evidence of implementing strategies in your home. The tasks are simple and can be done within the everyday activities you do with the children and will take a maximum of 20 minutes a week to write up.
- You will complete a CFHBS checklist with opportunities to showcase the changes you have made to their:
 - The physical environment
 - Interactions with children
 - Modelling and developing children's talking
 - The resources and opportunities for communication and learning.
 - The use made of books in supporting children's communication development
- Most of the evidence involves uploading photos.
- You will have a virtual visit from an Elklan Tutor who will observe the environment and your interaction and modelling skills with children. A few will have a face-toface visit (instead of a virtual visit).





CFHBS through Speech and Language Support for 3-5s (SLS)

- You will complete 10 interactive self-study eLearning sessions, one before each webinar linked to the session. Each eLearning session takes approximately one hour but can be done at your own pace at a time that suits you.
- You will attend 11 live group webinars in groups of approximately 10, to discuss your learning with an Elklan Tutor and with each other and have opportunities to reflect on the implementation of strategies from the course and share experiences in consistent small groups. The webinars total 14 hours and are held at the same time and day of the week throughout the programme, excluding half terms and school holidays. and the immediate pre-Christmas period). Timetables are provided on the final pages.

- You will complete an online learning log of evidence of implementing and evaluating strategies. Implementing planned activities might take an hour a week and writing up the Learning Log will take up to an hour a week.
- You will complete a CFHBS checklist with opportunities to showcase the changes they have made to their:
 - The physical environment
 - Interactions with children
 - Modelling and developing children's talking
 - Resources and opportunities for communication and learning
 - Use made of books in supporting children's communication development
 - Most of the evidence involves uploading photos
- You will have a virtual visit from an Elklan Tutor who will observe the environment and your interaction and modelling skills with children. A few will have a face-toface visit (instead of a virtual visit).

What is involved in being part of the pilot study?

The research team from the Universities of York and Sheffield are exploring the feasibility of the 2 programme variants[1] for childminders. You will be asked to complete two short online surveys (at the beginning and end of the training) about your experiences of training and its impact in your home-based setting. Interviews may also be conducted with a small number of childminders.





What is the cost to the childminder?

- The training, resources and external accreditation are all fully funded by the EEF and Stronger Practice Hubs.
- If you complete the programme, you will receive a financial contribution towards the cost of your time, calculated to be approximately 50% of an early years practitioners hourly rate.
- You will also receive a payment for your time and involvement in the research element of the programme.

Who can take part?

Childminders who:

- Anticipate having at least one child, aged 2-5 years, in their care during 2023/24.
- Have sufficient computer skills to log onto the Elklan site, access live webinars and manage their Learning Log including uploading photos.

[1] The variants being Elklan's Let's Talk with Under 5s and Creating Communication Friendly Home-Based Settings courses (LTU5s + CFHBS) OR Elklan's Speech and Language Support for 3-5s and Creating Communication Friendly Home-Based Settings (SLS3-5s + CFHBS) courses

• Are in Pen Green SPH which include the local authorities: North Northamptonshire, West Northamptonshire, Leicestershire, Leicester, Rutland and Lincolnshire.

To complete CFHBS through the SLS route you need to have gained a minimum of at least one A level, or NVQ level 3 or National Diploma level qualification in the past. Whereas the LTU5s route only requires you to have 3 or more GCSEs at garages 1-3/D-G or above.

Next Steps

You can express a preference for undertaking CFHBS through the LTU5s or SLS route (if you meet the eligibility criteria) and state whether you would prefer a September 2023 or January 2024 start date via the below link. The deadline for applications is 20th June 2023. After that deadline, or if there is over subscription to one route or date, places will be randomly allocated



Timelines




LT U5s / CFHBS Combination - September 2023 Start




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SLS 3-5s / CFHBS Combination - September 2023 Start
